CHAPTER 1 – UNIVERSITIES

1.0 Background

There are four publicly funded universities in Manitoba, each operating under separate legislation and defined as universities under the Council on Post-Secondary Education Act: the University of Manitoba (UM), the University of Winnipeg (UW), Brandon University (BU) and Collège universitaire de Saint-Boniface (CUSB) which is an affiliated college of The University of Manitoba.

The UM is the largest, most comprehensive and only medical-doctoral university in Manitoba. In addition to offering undergraduate and graduate education in arts, science and other fields, UM offers programs in a broad range of professional areas. The UW, BU and CUSB are all primarily undergraduate institutions, which offer undergraduate and a limited number of graduate programs in arts, and education, as well as specialized programs on an institution-by-institution basis. CUSB offers university programming in French.

On some tables, data in this Chapter may differ from the September 2005 edition. Data in this document should be considered correct, as some institutions have revised their data. Where this has occurred, “Revised” will be noted.

1.1 Total Enrollment

1.1.1 Total Enrollment – All Sessions

The “total student enrollment for all sessions” is the sum of all full-time and part-time students at each university in Manitoba. This includes undergraduate and graduate enrollments in both the regular session and spring/summer sessions. Total enrollment is a student headcount, which is the sum of all full-time (FT) and part-time (PT) students.

“Full-time equivalent” enrollment (FTE) is a calculation that equalizes all students to full-time status. This calculation takes the number of part-time students and it divides by 3.5, which, according to Statistics Canada, will give a figure equivalent to the number of students attending university full-time. When this number is added to the number of full-time students, the result is FTE.

Enrollment is a discrete count of students in each session; regular session (full-time or part-time) and/or spring/summer session (full-time or part-time). Therefore a student may be counted twice if enrolled in both sessions in an academic year. Statistics Canada does not report a student twice in one academic year. As a result, data reported in the Compendium may not be completely parallel to Statistics Canada data.

Regular session data are reported by the universities as of November 1 annually, and includes students who have paid tuition fees. Spring and summer data are reported two days following the voluntary withdrawal date of the final summer session term.

The chart below shows that for the five-year period from 2000/01 to 2004/05, the distribution of total student enrollment by university remained unchanged. UM accounts for just over two-thirds or 67.6% of total university enrollment, UW 20.7%, BU 9.4%, and CUSB 2.3%.

All universities show a similar trend in enrollment change over the five-year period. Enrollment increased steadily in each year between 2000/01 and 2004/05. In 2004/05, enrollment increased an average of 4% at all universities over prior year.

Cumulatively between 2000/01 and 2004/05 total enrollment increased by 11,370 students or 27.5%. Following the same trend, both full and part time enrollment increased by 25.9% (6,058 students), and 29.6% (5,312 students) respectively.

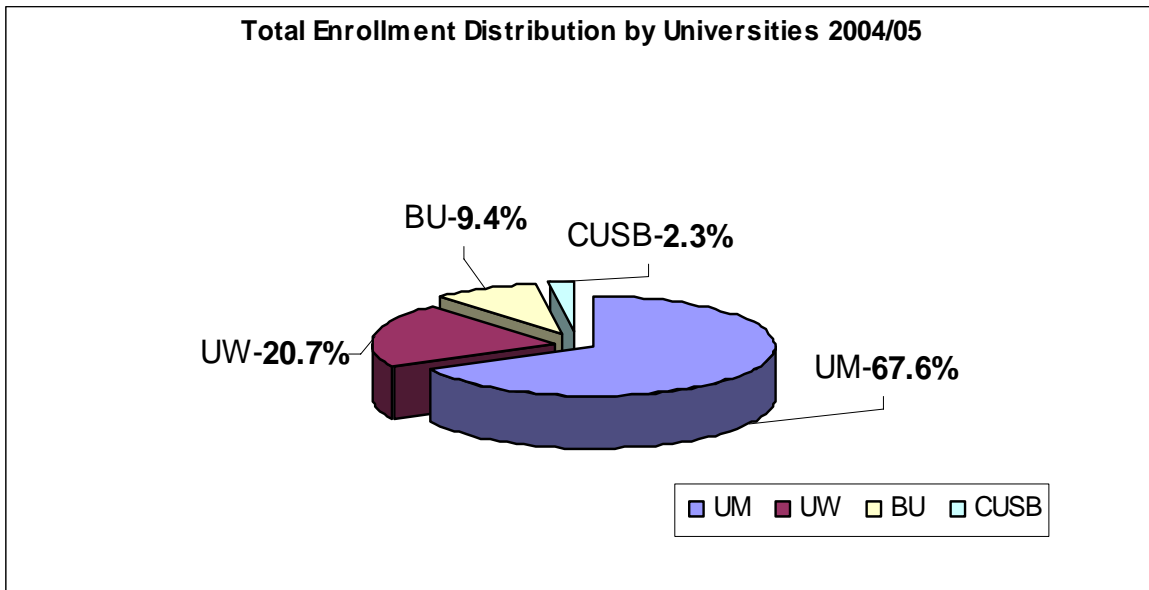


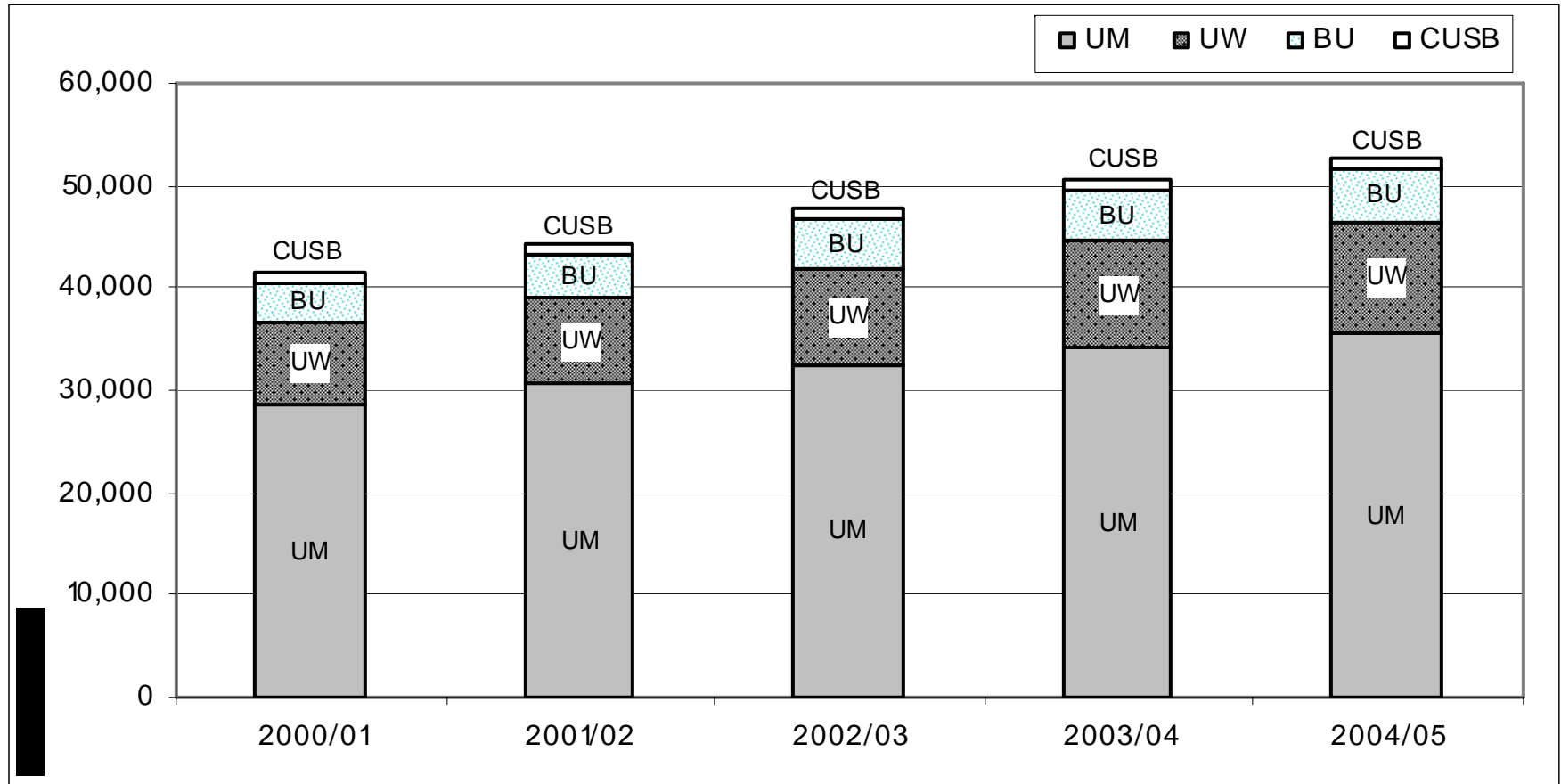

1.1.2 Total Enrollment – Regular Session

Regular session at universities is from September to April and comprises one full academic year. Both full and part time students enroll during regular session.

Total enrollment for regular session, as found in Table 1.1.2, shows a similar trend over time to that of total enrollment. Between 2000/01 to 2004/05 total regular session enrollment increased at all four universities by 8,779 students or 27.5%.

Overall total FTE's also increased between 2000/01 to 2004/05 by 6,564 students or 25.5%.

Similar to the total enrollment data, regular session full-time enrollment (which comprised 71.8% of total enrollment in 2004/05) increased each year between 2000/01 and 2004/05. The highest full-time enrollment increase was between 2002/03 to 2003/04 by 2,060 students or 7.9%

Overall, there was an increase of students 6,047 (26.0%) in regular session full-time enrollment and an increase of 2,732 (31.2%) part-time regular session students over the five-year period.

1.1.3 Total Enrollment – Spring/Summer Session

Interession, spring and summer sessions operate at universities between May and August and include both full and part time graduate and undergraduate students.

Table 1.1.3 shows that between 2000 and 2004 almost all spring and summer session enrollment at each university was comprised of part-time students. BU and CUSB did not offer full-time spring and summer session programming. Part time enrollment continues to dominate 2004 spring and summer session; 98.0% of total enrollment was part-time students, and 2.0% was full-time.

In the period of 2000 and 2004, the proportions of regular session enrollment (77.3%) and spring/summer session enrollment (22.7%) of the total enrollment remained relatively unchanged.

1.2 Undergraduate Enrollment

This section includes undergraduate enrollment data from 2000/01 to 2004/05 by session, gender, age, and for international students.

1.2.1 Undergraduate Enrollment – All Sessions

In the five year period of 2000/01 to 2004/05, overall total undergraduate full-time enrollment all session increased by 5,495 students (25.9%). Part-time enrollment also showed similar trend with an increase of 4,951 students (29.9%) in the same 5 year period.

The summary below illustrates that in 2004/05, the distribution of undergraduate enrollment by universities are; UM – 65.4%, UW – 22.6%, BU – 9.7%, CUSB – 2.3%. Cumulatively over the 5 year period, Undergraduate enrollment increased by 27.6% or 10,446 students.

Cumulatively total undergraduate regular session enrollments between 2000/01 to 2004/05 show an increase of 8,067 students (28.0%) a five year period. University of Winnipeg had the largest percentage increase of 2,388 (37.6%).

Full and part time undergraduate regular session enrollments showed a similar trend to that of total regular session enrollments. Overall, full-time enrollment increased by 5,484 students (26.1%), while part-time enrollment increased by 2,583 students or 33.1%.

1.2.9 Undergraduate Enrollment of International Students

Table 1.2.9 shows that in general, undergraduate international student enrollment increased significantly over the five-year period at all universities. International student enrollment had exceeded the 2000/01 level by 1,599 from 789 in 1999/00 to 2,388 in 2004/05 (or 202.7%).

1.3 Graduate Enrollment

1.3.1 Graduate Enrollment – All Sessions

Table 1.3.1 shows that over the five-year period, UM accounted for just over 91.2% (4,096 students) of total graduate enrollment. This is to be expected, given that the other universities are primarily undergraduate institutions.

Full-time graduate enrollment has decreased over the five year period at UW and BU, while part time enrollment in both institutions continues to accelerate over the same period; 16.0% and 45.1% respectively.

Overall, part-time graduate enrollment increased by 26.9% (361 students), while total full-time graduate enrollment increased by 25.3% or 563 students between 2000/01 and 2004/05.

1.3.2 Graduate Enrollment – Regular Session

Regular session full-time graduate enrollment showed a similar trend to total graduate enrollment, with an increase of 563 students or 25.3%, while total part-time enrollment increased by 149 students (15.7%) between 2000/01 and 2004/05.

Overall, graduate regular session enrollment increased by 712 students or 22.4%.

1.3.3 Graduate Enrollment – Spring/Summer Session

As Table 1.3.3 shows, part time graduate enrollment for spring and summer session increased by 212 students or 54.1% between 2000 to 2004. (All graduate students taking part in spring and summer session are considered part time.)

Over the five-year period, regular session graduate enrollment comprised 86.6%, and spring and summer session 13.4% of the total graduate student enrollment. Overall, graduate spring and summer session enrollment accounted for approximately 5% of total spring and summer session enrollment.

1.3.4 Graduate Enrollment by Gender – Regular Session

1.4 Degrees Granted

1.4.1 Total Degrees Granted

As Table 1.4.1 shows, in the five-year period from 2000 to 2004 the total number of degrees granted by Manitoba's universities fluctuated annually. The number of university degrees granted increased from 5,343 in 2000 to 6,453 in 2004 – an increase of 1,110 or 20.8%.

Distribution of the total degrees granted by university in 2004 shows; the UM/CUSB granted 71.7%, UW 19.2%, and BU 9.1%.

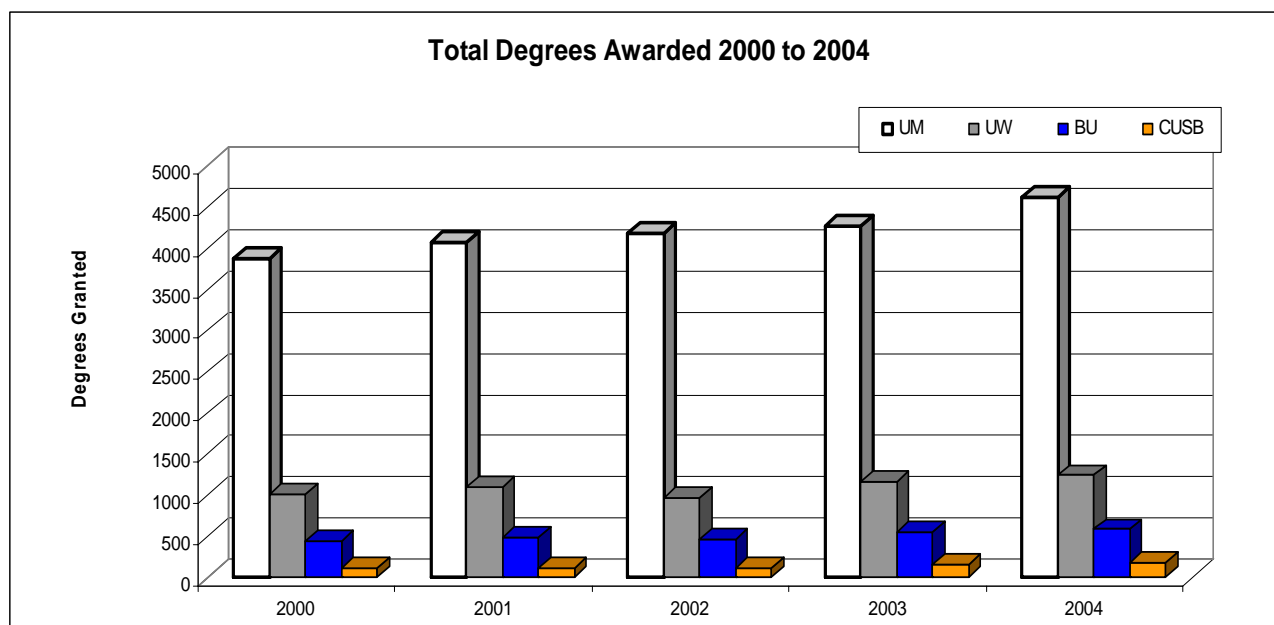
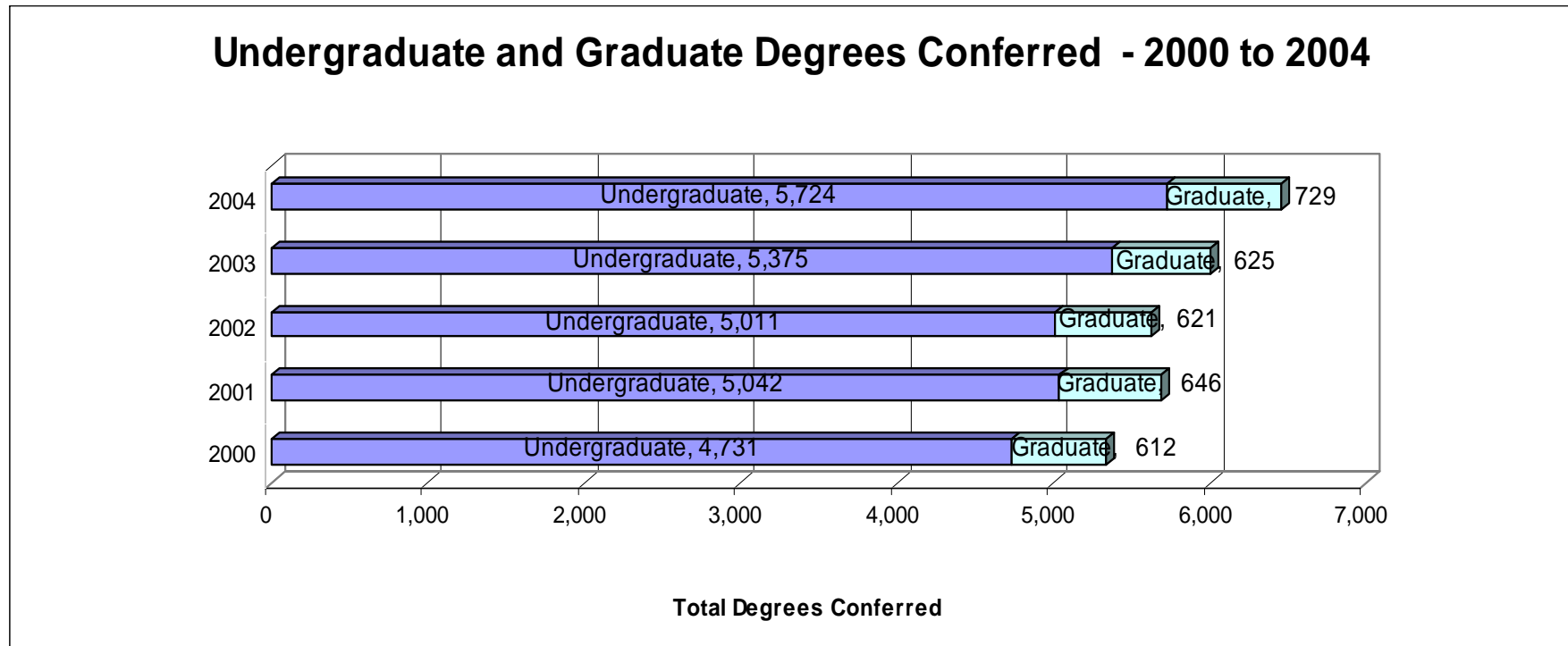


Table 1.4.1 (b) Total Degrees Conferred – Undergraduate and Graduate, All Universities



1.4.2 Undergraduate Degrees and Degrees Granted by Gender

Table 1.4.2 shows, over the five-year period, the number of degrees granted increased by 21.0% (993 graduates).

Of the total undergraduate degrees granted in 2000, 59.0% degrees were granted to women and 41.1% to men. By 2004, the proportion of women receiving undergraduate degrees had increased to 62.9%, while the proportion of men receiving degrees had slipped to 37.1%.

Analysis by gender shows that over the five-year period, the number of women receiving undergraduate degrees increased by 29.0% (808 graduates), while the number of men receiving undergraduate degrees increased only 9.4% (182 graduates).

1.4.3 Graduate Degrees and Degrees Granted by Gender

The total graduate degrees granted by Manitoba's universities between 2000 and 2004 increased by 117 or 19.1%, as shown in Table 1.4.3. The data also shows that in 2000 women received 326 (53.3%), and men 286 (46.7%) of total graduate degrees granted. In 2004, these proportions increased slightly, women receiving 394 (54.0%), and decreased slightly for men 335 (46.0%) of total graduate degrees granted.
