CHAPTER 2 – COLLEGES

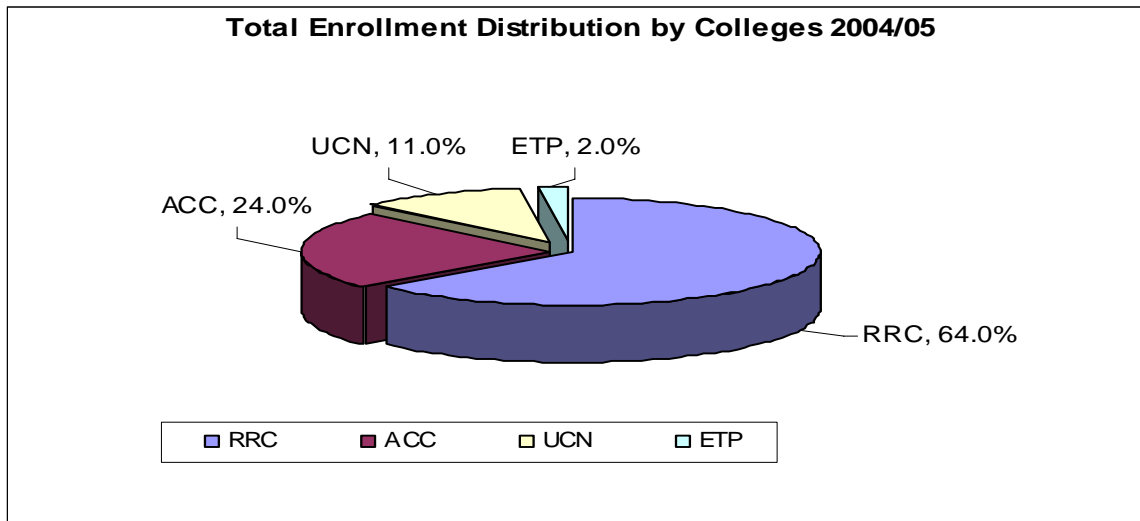
2.0 Background

The data in this chapter report on community college activity for the five year period between 2000/01 and 2004/05. Keewatin Community College (KCC) is now University College of the North (UCN) which began operation in the 2004/05 fiscal year. The other institutions that are included in this section are Red River College (RRC), Assiniboine Community College (ACC) and École technique et professionnelle (ETP), the community college division of College de Saint Boniface.

2.1 Enrollment

College enrollment data are collected and reported in conjunction with Statistics Canada reporting methods. Data are reported annually as of August 31.

In 2000/01, distribution of total enrollment in colleges in Manitoba was: RRC (67%), ACC (22%), UCN (10%), and ÉTP (1%). By 2004/05, these distributions had shifted slightly, with RRC accounting for (64.0%) of the total college population, while ACC accounted for (24%), UCN (11%) and ETP (2%).

2.1.1 Enrollment by College

As Table 2.1.1 illustrates, the colleges' enrollment increased steadily between 2000/01 and 2004/05. In the five year period, overall enrollment increased by 2,339 students (or 19.3%).

Enrollment on a full-time basis accounted for 86.1% of total enrollment in 2004/05. This is a decline of 8.7% from 2000/01, when full-time enrollment accounted for 94.8% of total enrollment.

In addition, full-time enrollment increased 8.4% (or 966 students) between 2000/01 and 2004/05. While total part-time enrollment more than doubled by 1,373 students (or 218.3%) in the same five-year period.

2.1.4 Enrollment by Aboriginal Status

Since Aboriginal status is self-declared by each student, there are limited data available for analysis. However, the data available in Table 2.1.4 indicate over the five year period enrollment of self-declared Aboriginal students increased by 31.4% or 592 students from 2000/01 to 2004/05.

Further analysis of Table 2.1.4(a) shows that the percentage distribution of Aboriginal enrollment to total college enrollment at an average rate of 17.1% each year from 2000/01 to 2004/05.

In 2004/05, Aboriginal students' distribution to total college enrollment was: RRC (8.2%), ACC (19.5%), UCN (68.0%) and zero at ETP.

Graph 2.2.1 (a) Graduates by College

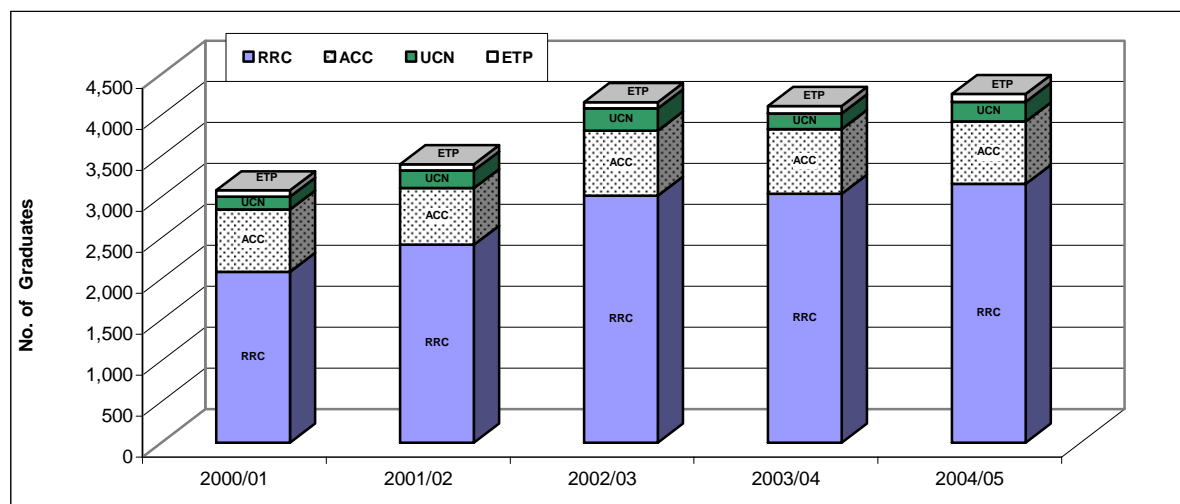
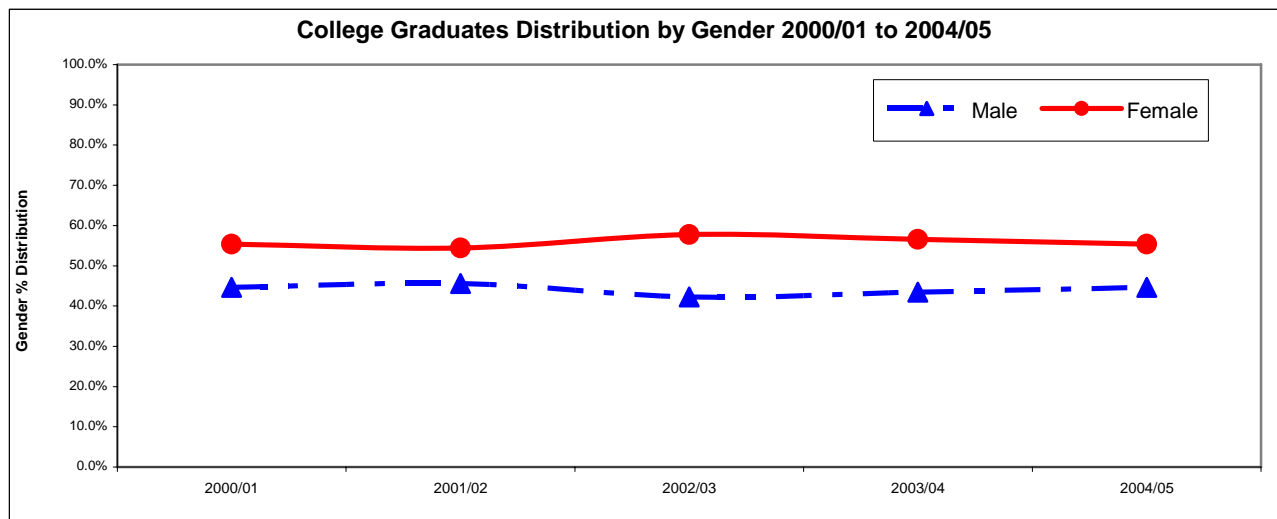
