CHAPTER 1 – UNIVERSITIES

1.0 Background

There are four funded public universities and one university college in Manitoba, each operating under separate legislation and defined as universities under the Council on Post-Secondary Education Act: the University of Manitoba (UM), the University of Winnipeg (UW), Brandon University (BU), Collège universitaire de Saint-Boniface (CUSB) which is an affiliated college of The University of Manitoba and University College of the North (UCN).

The UM is the largest, most comprehensive and only medical-doctoral university in Manitoba. In addition to offering undergraduate and graduate education in arts, science and other fields, UM offers programs in a broad range of professional areas. The UW, BU and CUSB are all primarily undergraduate institutions, which offer undergraduate and a limited number of graduate programs in arts, and education, as well as specialized programs on an institution-by-institution basis. CUSB offers university programming in French.

University College of the North was established July 1, 2004 replacing Keewatin Community College (KCC). Bachelor of Arts was the first degree program offered at UCN in 2005/06 and in 2006/07 the Kanaci Otinawawasowin – midwifery degree program was introduced. College-level programming offered through the former KCC is available through the new university college. Programming is available at the two main campuses in Thompson and The Pas, as well as through a network of regional centres in smaller communities throughout northern Manitoba.

On some tables, data in this Chapter may differ from the September 2008 edition. Data in this document should be considered correct, as some institutions have revised their data.

1.1 Total Enrollment

1.1.1 Total Enrollment – All Sessions

The “total student enrollment for all sessions” is the sum of all full-time and part-time students at each university in Manitoba. This includes undergraduate and graduate enrollments in both the regular session and spring/summer sessions. Total enrollment is a student headcount, which is the sum of all full-time (FT) and part-time (PT) students.

"Full-time equivalent" enrollment (FTE) is a calculation that equalizes all students to full-time status. This calculation takes the number of part-time students and it divides by 3.5, which, according to Statistics Canada, will give a figure equivalent to the number of students attending university full-time. When this number is added to the number of full-time students, the result is FTE.

Enrollment is a discrete count of students in each session; regular session (full-time or part-time) and/or spring/summer session (full-time or part-time). Therefore a student may be counted twice if enrolled in both sessions in an academic year. Statistics Canada does not report a student twice in one academic year. As a result, data reported in the Compendium may not be completely parallel to Statistics Canada data.

Regular session data are reported by the universities as of November 1 annually, and includes students who have paid tuition fees; fall and/or winter session. Spring and summer data are reported two days following the voluntary withdrawal date of the final summer session term.

The chart below shows that for the five-year period from 2003/04 to 2007/08, the distribution of total student enrollment by university remained unchanged. UM accounts for just over two-thirds or 68% of total university enrollment, UW 21%, BU 8%, CUSB 2% and UCN 1%.

All universities are showing an enrollment slow down in 2007/08 over previous year, except of UCN with an increase of 15.8% over previous year. An overall enrollment decrease of 1.6% is observed in 2007/08.

Despite the slow down in 2007/08, cumulatively between 2003/04 and 2007/08 total enrollment increased by 2,883 students or 5.7%. Following the same trend, both full and part time enrollment increased by 7.7% (2,176 students), and 3.1% (707 students) respectively.

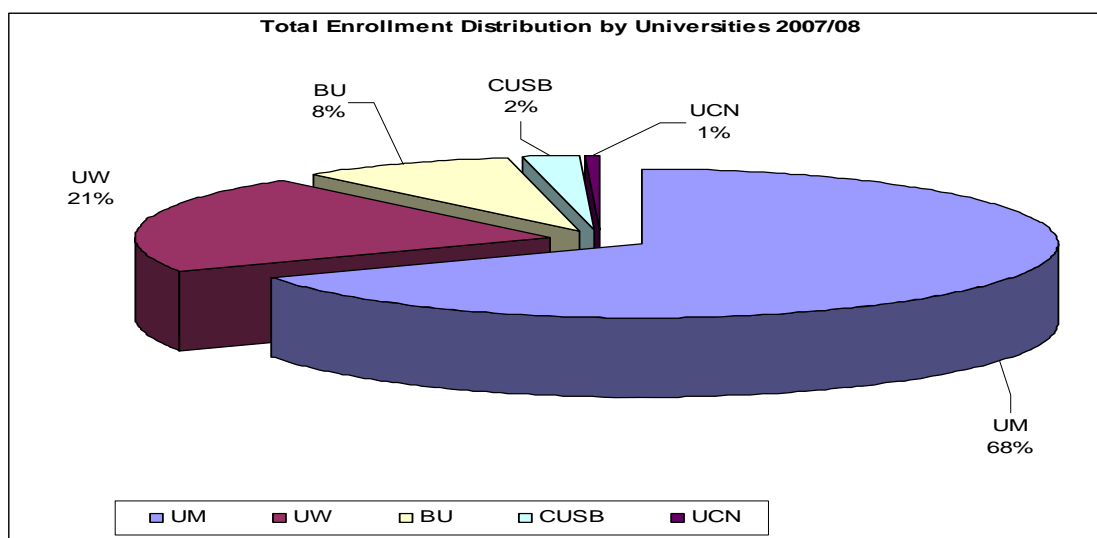


Table 1.1.1 – Total Enrollment -All Sessions 5 Year Trend 2003/04 to 2007/08

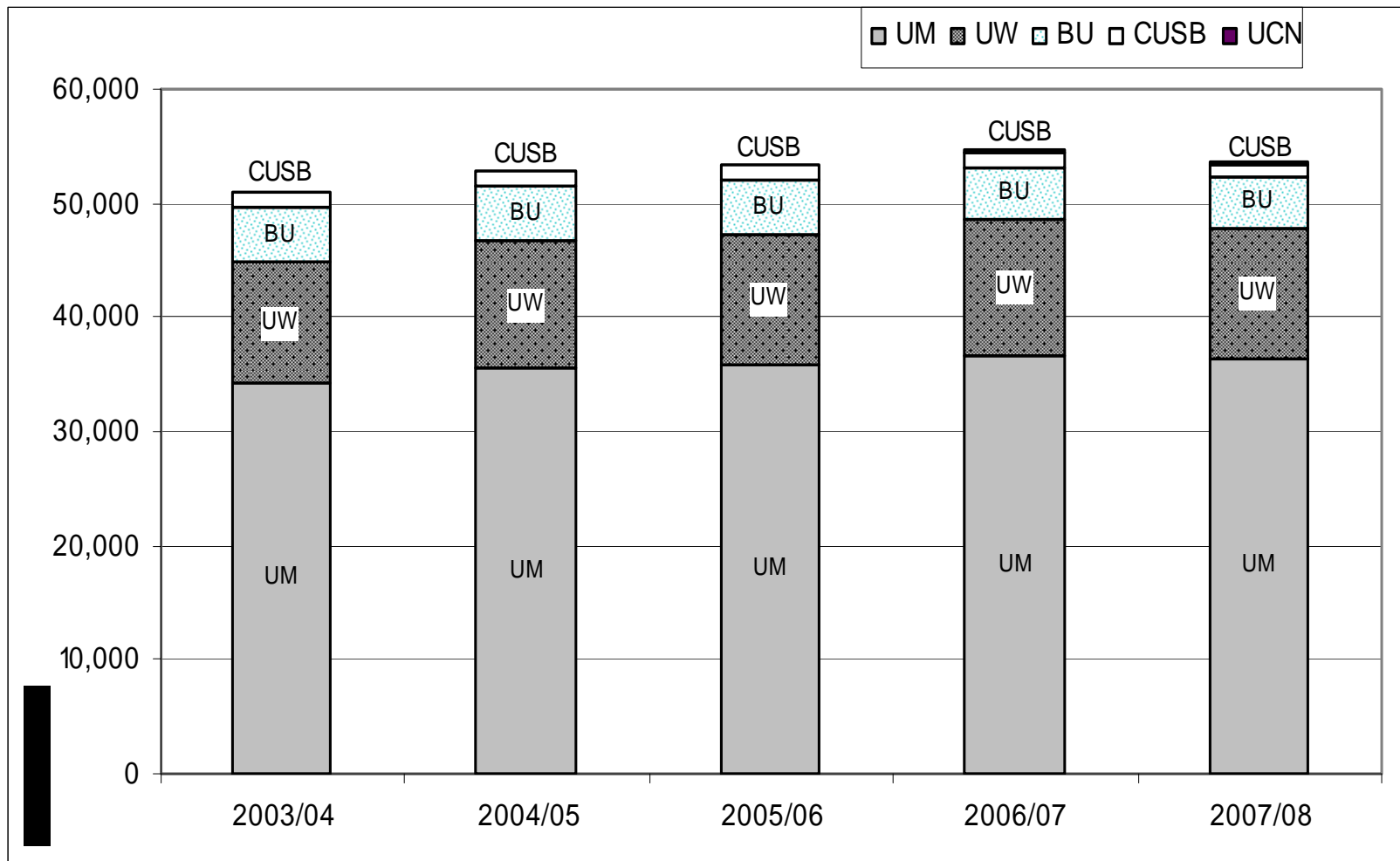

1.1.2 Total Enrollment – Regular Session

In general, regular session at universities is from September to April and comprises one full academic year. Both full and part-time students enroll during regular session.

Total enrollment for regular session, as found in Table 1.1.2, shows a similar trend over time to that of total enrollment. Between 2003/04 to 2007/08 total regular session enrollment increased at all five universities by 859 students or 2.2%.

Overall total FTE's also increased between 2003/04 to 2007/08 by 1,939 students or 6.2%. Similar to the total enrollment data, regular session full-time enrollment (which comprised 76% of total enrollment in 2007/08) increased each year between 2003/04 and 2007/08.

Overall, there was an increase of 2,371 students (or 8.5%) in regular session full-time enrollment. Part-time regular session students over the five-year period is not comparable due to a registration system change in 2006 at UM, full/part-time breakdown unavailable, therefore all students in spring/summer session are counted as part-time.

1.1.3 Total Enrollment – Spring/Summer Session

Intersession, spring and summer sessions operate at universities between May and August and include both full and part-time graduate and undergraduate students.

Table 1.1.3 shows that between 2003 and 2007 almost all spring and summer session enrollment at each university was comprised of part-time students. BU, CUSB and UCN did not offer full-time spring and summer session programming. Part-time enrollment continues to dominate spring and summer session.

In the period of 2003 and 2007, the proportions of regular session enrollment (75%) and spring/summer session enrollment (25%) of the total enrollment remain unchanged.

1.2 Undergraduate Enrollment

This section includes undergraduate enrollment data from 2003/04 to 2007/08 by session, gender, age, and for international students.

1.2.1 Undergraduate Enrollment – All Sessions

In the five year period of 2003/04 to 2007/08, overall total undergraduate full-time enrollment for all session increased by 1,925 students (7.5%). Part-time enrollment also showed an increase of 567 students (2.7%) in the same 5 year period.

The summary below illustrates that in 2007/08, the distribution of undergraduate enrollment by universities is; UM – 65.5%, UW – 23.1%, BU – 8.6%, CUSB – 2.1% and UCN 0.7%. Cumulatively over the 5 year period, Undergraduate enrollment increased by 5.4% or 2,492 students.

Undergraduate regular session enrollment trends are similar to those of total regular session enrollments, only CUSB and UCN experienced increases in 2007/08, where as UM, UW and BU showed an enrollment decrease in the same period.

1.2.9 Undergraduate Enrollment of International Students

Table 1.2.9 shows that in general, undergraduate international student enrollment increased significantly over the five-year period at all universities. International student enrollment increased by 925 from 1,678 in 200/304 to 2,601 in 2007/08 (or 55%).

In 2007/08, the majority of undergraduate international students that came to universities in Manitoba were from Asia (1,877 students or 72.2%), Africa (321 students or 12.3%) and North & Central America (126 students or 4.8%).

1.3 Graduate Enrollment

1.3.1 Graduate Enrollment – All Sessions

Table 1.3.1 shows that in 2007/08, UM accounted for just over 87.8% (4,182 students) of total graduate enrollment. This is to be expected, given that the other universities are primarily undergraduate institutions.

Cumulatively, full-time graduate enrollment increased by 8.5% (232 students), while part-time graduate enrollment had an increase of 7% between 2003/04 and 2007/08.

1.3.2 Graduate Enrollment – Regular Session

Total regular session full-time graduate enrollment showed an increase of 232 students (or 9.4%) while total part-time enrollment decreased by 60 students (or -5.1%) between 2003/04 and 2007/08.

Overall, graduate regular session enrollment increased by 172 students or 5.0%.

1.3.3 Graduate Enrollment – Spring/Summer Session

Tables 1.3.2 and 1.3.3 shows, over the five-year period, regular session graduate enrollment comprised 85% and spring and summer session 15% of the total graduate student enrollment. Overall, graduate spring and summer session enrollment accounted for approximately 5.3% of total spring and summer session enrollment. (All graduate students taking part in spring and summer session are considered part-time.)

1.4 Degrees Granted

1.4.1 Total Degrees Granted

As Table 1.4.1 shows that in the five-year period from 2003 to 2007 the number of university degrees granted increased from 6,000 in 2003 to 6,910 in 2007 – an increase of 910 or 15.2%.

Distribution of the total degrees granted by university in 2007 shows; the UM/CUSB granted 69.5%, UW 21.5%, and BU 9.0%.

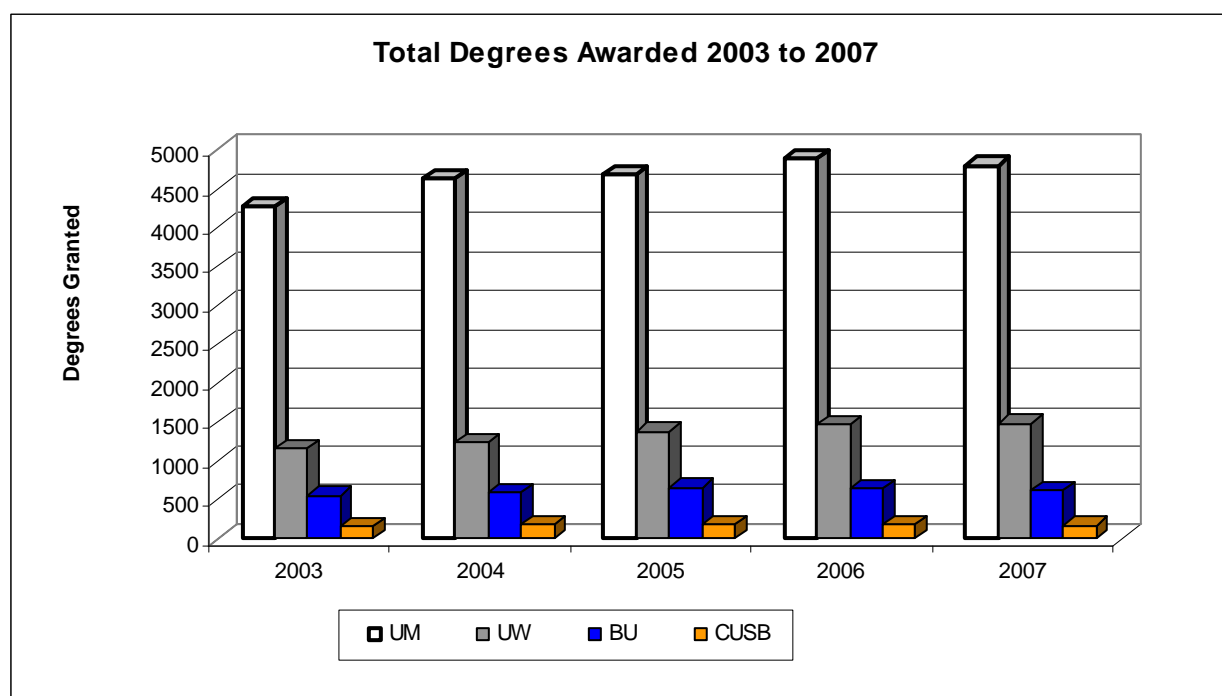
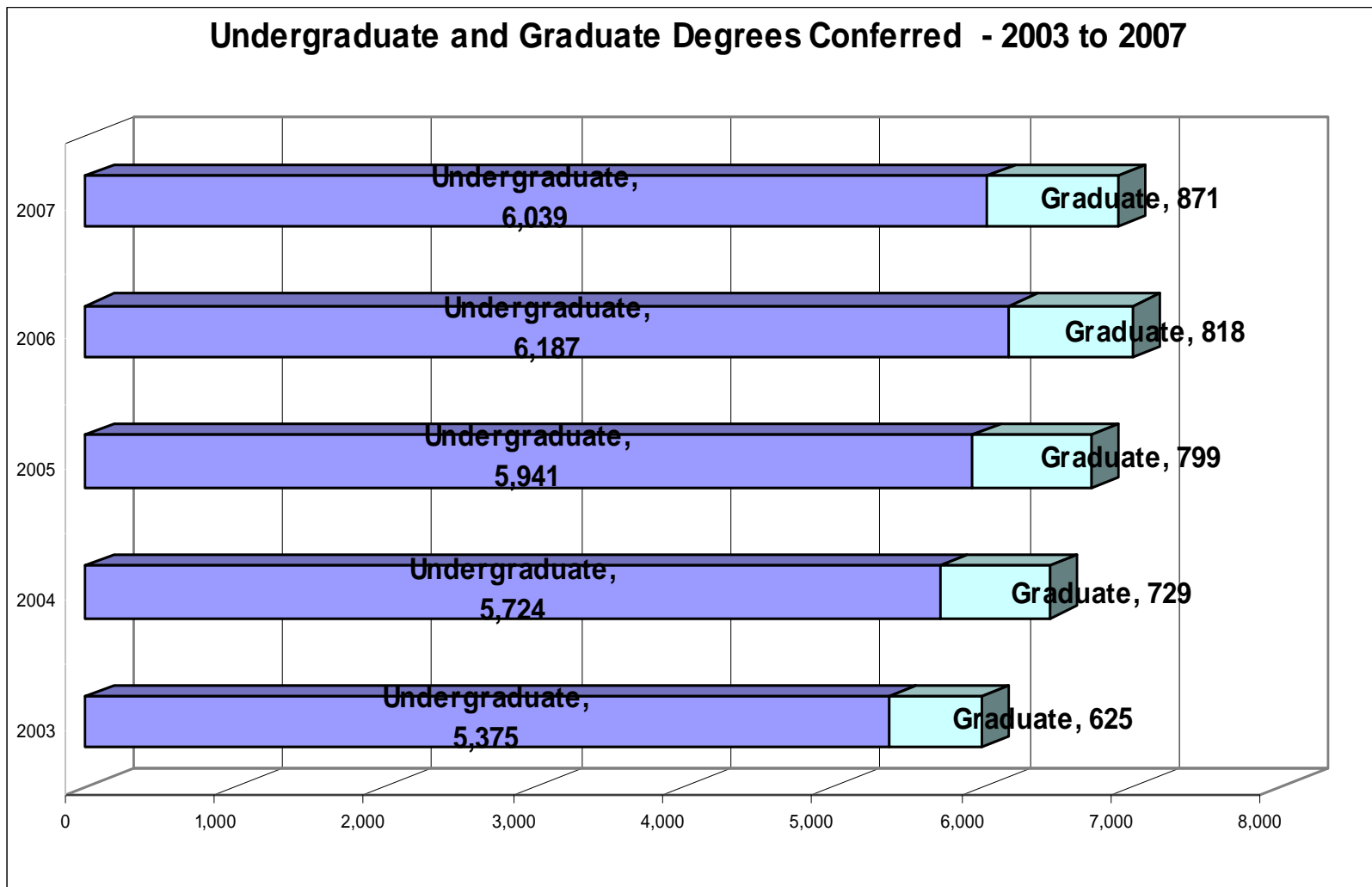


Table 1.4.1 (b) Total Degrees Conferred – Undergraduate and Graduate, All Universities



1.4.2 Undergraduate Degrees and Degrees Granted by Gender

Table 1.4.2 shows, over the five-year period, the number of undergraduate degrees granted increased by 12% (664 graduates).

Of the total undergraduate degrees granted in 2003, 62.5% degrees were granted to women and 37.5% to men. By 2007, the proportion of women receiving undergraduate degrees had decreased to 61.0%, while the proportion of men receiving degrees increase to 39%.

Analysis by gender shows that over the five-year period, the number of women and men receiving undergraduate degrees increased by 10% (or 324 graduates) and 17% (or 340 graduates) respectively.

1.4.3 Graduate Degrees Granted by Gender and Credential

The total graduate degrees granted by Manitoba's universities between 2003 and 2007 increased by 246 or 39.4%, as shown in Table 1.4.3. The data also shows that in 2003 women received 341 (54.6%), and men 284(45.4%) of total graduate degrees granted. In 2007, the women received 477 (or 54.8%), and decreased slightly for men 394 (or 45.2%) of total graduate degrees granted.
