CHAPTER 2 – COLLEGES

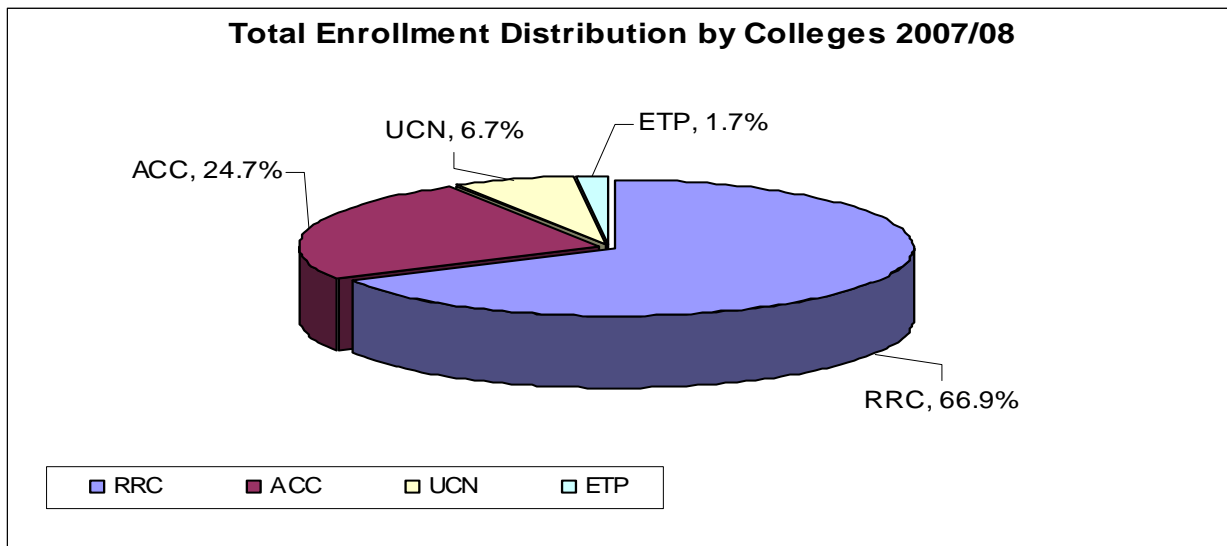
2.0 Background

The data in this chapter reports on community college activity for the five year period between 2003/04 and 2007/08. Established in July 2004, University College of the North (UCN) replaced Keewatin Community College (KCC), offering both university degree programs and college programs in 2005/06 and only college programs data are included in this chapter. The other institutions that are included in this section are Red River College (RRC), Assiniboine Community College (ACC) and École technique et professionnelle (ETP), the community college division of Collège universitaire de Saint Boniface.

2.1 Enrollment

College enrollment data are collected and reported in conjunction with Statistics Canada reporting methods. Data are reported annually as of August 31.

2007/08 college enrolment distribution is as follows: 2007/08, RRC has the largest portion of (66.9%) of the total college population, while ACC accounted for (24.7%), UCN (6.7%) and ETP (1.7%).

2.1.1 Enrollment by College

As Table 2.1.1 illustrates, the colleges' enrollment increased steadily between 2003/04 and 2007/08. In the five year period, overall enrollment increased by 1,232 students (or 8.5%).

Enrollment on a full-time basis accounted for 87.4% of total enrollment in 2007/08. This is an increase of 0.3% from 2006/07, when full-time enrollment accounted for 87.1% of total enrollment.

In addition, full-time enrollment increased 7.1% (or 912 students) between 2003/04 and 2007/08. Similarly part-time enrollment jumped 19.4% (or 320 students) in the same five-year period.

2.1.4 Enrollment by Aboriginal Status

Since Aboriginal status is self-declared process, enrollment count may be understated. Data in Table 2.1.4 indicate over the five year period enrollment of Aboriginal students increased by 8.2% or 182 students from 2003/04 to 2007/08.

Table 2.1.4(a) shows in 2007/08, Aboriginal students' distribution to total college enrollment was: RRC (8.3%), ACC (15.4%), UCN (85.1%) and ETP reported zero percentage. In the five year period, percentage distribution of Aboriginal students at UCN increased by 24.5% from 60.6% to 85.1%.

Average Aboriginal student distribution to total college enrollment is 16% over the five year period.

Graph 2.2.1 (a) Graduates by College

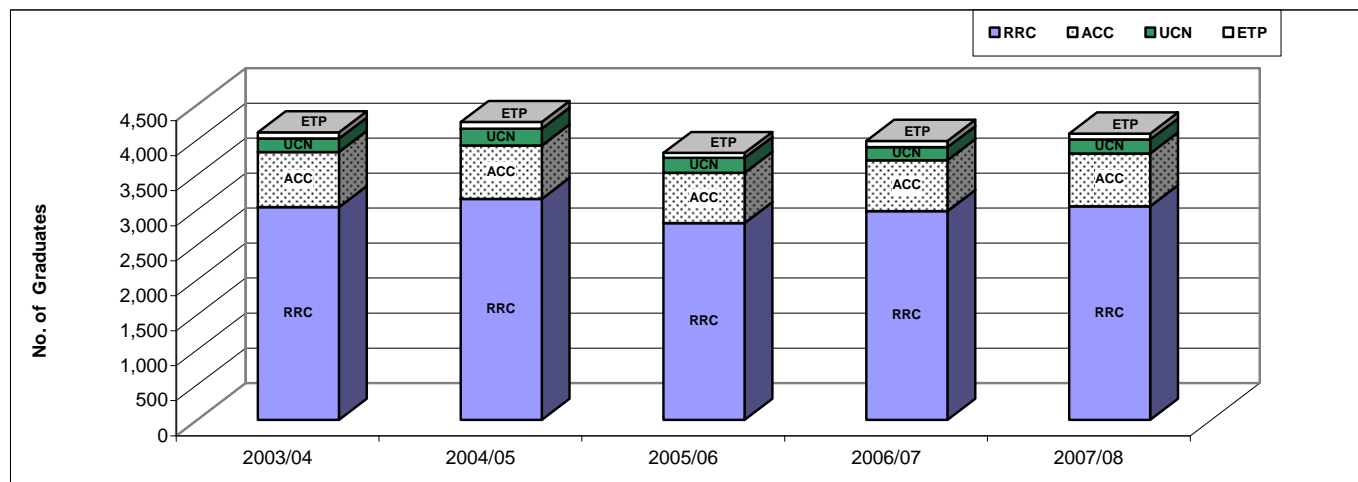
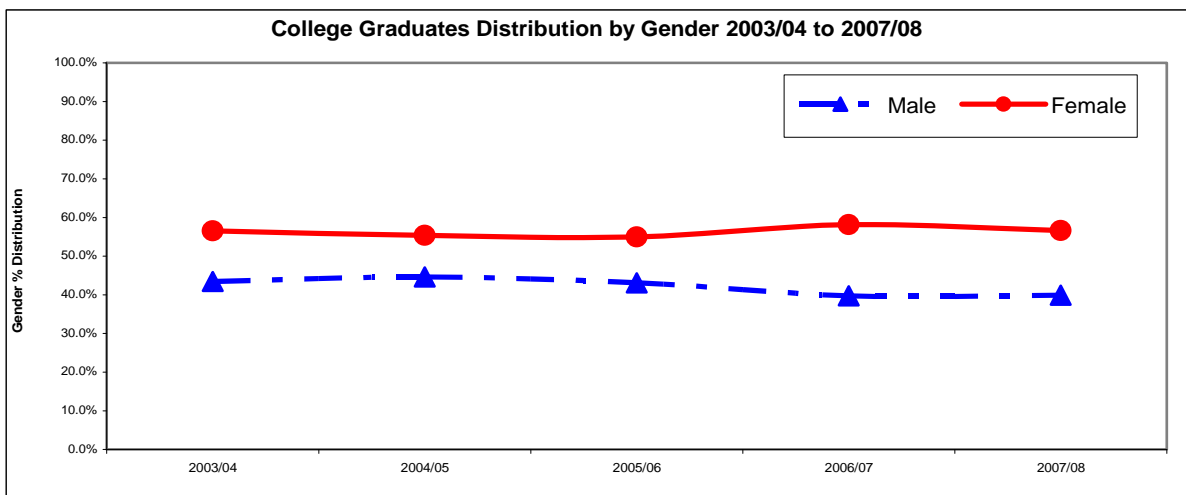
